

# CLBC Directors Meeting

June 12, 2024, at 1300(1pm)

**Treasurer Report:** Property tax for 2024 is \$15,436. The City of Chilliwack granted us a permissive tax exemption for this. Bank Balance as of May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024, is \$10,121. \$3,000 is internally reserved for gutter repairs, and cheques not cashed are \$2,461. Membership is twenty full play bowlers. A grant submission was made to BC Gaming for \$4,000 for greens outdoor lights and \$5,000 to purchase sets of smaller bowl sizes to accommodate younger players. Revenue and Expense summaries are attached.

## Old Business:

1. The board met with representatives of various City departments to further discuss what help the city could provide for our future. Information on this will be sent out shortly and an Extraordinary Meeting will be held to obtain your input on next steps.
2. CLBC shirts—we will try to obtain some sample shirts for membership to evaluate.
3. July 1<sup>st</sup> Celebration will be a 1000 morning bowl followed by a BBQ luncheon for \$15—one Hamburger or two Hotdogs and all the trimmings included. There will be a 50/50 draw, and afternoon bowling.
4. The first Tournament -Men's and Women's Pairs was held on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of June. The Tournament schedule is posted in the locker room and the entrance fee is \$10 per person.

For each Tournament, a signup sheet will be posted in the locker room, two weeks prior to the date. You will have 10 days to sign up and the fee is due before this sheet comes down or you are not eligible to play. The tournament rules are also posted for your review and cannot be changed. The tournament dates and times are as posted, and the tournament must be completed within the week it's scheduled for. Do not sign up for a tournament if you cannot meet these requirements.
